BYLAW NUMBER 2006-07 OF THE TOWN OF MAIDSTONE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN

The Council of the Town of Maidstone, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This bylaw may be cited as Special Business Licenses Bylaw

in this bylaw:

Bylaw Enforcement Officer means the Bylaw Enforcement Office for the (a)

Council means the Council of the Town. (b)

- License Inspector means the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or any person (c) appointed by Council for the purpose of enforcing this bylaw.
- Person means an individual or a group of two or more individuals or a (d) corporation.

Town means the Town of Maidstone, Province of Saskatchewan. (e)

- Town Administrator means the Administrator for the Town of Maidstone. **(f)**
- The Clerk/Administrator of the Municipality is hereby authorized to issue a (a) license to any person carrying on a business, trade or calling, and

who makes application for such license stating specifically the nature of (b)

his business in the municipality; and

- who tenders with is application the proper license fee as provided for in (c) Section 11.
- No person shall carry on within the Town any business, industry, calling or (a) occupation unless he possesses a valid and subsisting license for such purpose issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.

License fees shall become due and a special business license shall be (b) applied for on January 1st of each year or at any time during the year immediately upon a person engaging in a business, industry, calling or occupation which requires a license pursuant to this bylaw.

Every license issued pursuant to this bylaw shall expire on December 31 next following the date of issue unless sooner suspended or revoked, (c) expecting where a lesser period of time may be stated on the license issued. The six month license shall run from January 1st until June 30th or July 1st until December 31st in the year of issue. For such license shall be 50% of the fee stated in Section 11.

No person to whom a license has been granted pursuant to this Bylaw (d) shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise, or solicit orders for

future delivery of goods for merchandise within the Town: other than the kind or kinds described in the license, or

by any method except as stated in the license;

in all cases a license shall be applied for and the appropriate fee paid for each and every business, industry, calling or occupation mentioned in this (e) Bylaw, notwithstanding that more than one of the businesses, industries calling or occupations are carried on in one place or premises unless otherwise stated in this Bylaw.

In all cases where the Government of Canada and/or the Government of (f) the Province of Saskatchewan require any person to obtain a federal or provincial license in respect of any business, trade, calling or occupation, no license shall be granted under the provisions of the Bylaw unless and until the applicant shall have first obtained and produced the said federal

or provincial license. Every license issued under this Bylaw shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the license is authorized to offer for sale or take orders for as the case may be and whether in the case of goods or merchandise, he may offer the same for sale by retail or by

public auction or both.

(g)

- One copy of every license issued pursuant to this bylaw shall, at all (h) easonable time, upon request of the License Inspector, Town Administrator, Peace Officer, or any Town Official produce each license for inspection purposes.
- All applicants for a license shall state: (a)

the name and address of the applicant

the nature of the license applied for (ii)

the place where the proposed trade is exercised or where the same (iii) is to be carried on

such information as may be required by the License Inspector

No person to whom a license is granted under the provisions of this Bylaw shall conduct the business so licensed on any street, lane or property of the Town or on any road allowance or road, street or lane vested in Her Majesty or set aside for such purpose under the The North West Territories Act or an Act of Saskatchewan or any other public place in the Town which is under the direction and control of the Council as set out in The Municipalities Act, or a amendments thereto, without first have obtained express written consent in accordance with a resolution of the Council, except as otherwise provided for in this Bylaw.

Any person who carriers on a business, industry, calling or occupation (a) which is required to be licensed under this Bylaw without first having obtained a license to do so shall commit an offence and be liable to the penalty as herein provided.

Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to (b) comply therewith shall commit an offence and be liable to the penalty as

herein provided.

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw if guilty (c) of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine or not more than:

\$250.00 in the case of an individual a)

\$1,000.00 in the case of a corporation b)

but not less than:

\$50.00 in the case of an individual

\$250.00 in the case of a corporation þ)

In case of a conviction under the provisions of this Bylaw the convicting justice shall order payment of the required license fee and compliance with any other provisions of this Bylaw in addition to the penalty provided herein.

A person who fails with the period specified in an order under d) subsection (c) to comply with the order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a further penalty of twenty percent

of the fine levied.

In this Bylaw, the expression Transient Trader shall have the meaning as prescribed thereto by Section 9 1 c (i) (ii) of the Municipalities Act.

No person shall carry on any business, trade or calling set out in Section 11 of this Bylaw within the municipality unless he has in his possession a valid and subsisting license for the purposes issued in accordance with the provisions of this Bylaw.

Council may by resolution suspend or revoke any License granted under (a) the provision of this bylaw.

At the discretion of the Council, the license may be entitled to a refund of a (b) part of the License fee proportionate to the unexpired part of the term for which it was granted.
