TOWN NEWS

Speeding has become an issue in our Town and to combat this we have added speed bumps on some of our streets. A new 4-way stop sign has been added at 2nd Ave East & 2nd St East in the school zone. We will be marking September 10th as World Suicide Prevention Day as part of an International Awareness Campaign.

ROAD UPDATE

We are happy to say that 4th, 5th & 6th Avenues and most connecting streets are sand sealed. We will be doing more sand seal coating in 2018. This Fall we will be working on culverts and back alleys in preparation for work to be done in 2018.

RCMP

Since January 1st 2017, the Maidstone RCMP has responded to 62 reports of stolen vehicles. The importance of keeping keys and other valuables out of vehicles cannot be stressed enough. Most vehicles stolen in our area have had keys left in them or easily accessible with the doors unlocked.

WATER

The Town of Maidstone's permit to install an RO unit has been approved by the Water Security Agency. The Town is waiting for final approval from the Local Government Committee.
