BYLAW 2007-05

A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION;
SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES

The Council of the Town of Maidstone in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "Municipality" shall mean the Town of Maidstone;
 - b. "Service Provider" shall mean a municipality, co-operative, board or other entity who has been engaged by the Municipality to provide the fire prevention, suppression or other emergency response service
2. Fire suppression and/or prevention services shall be delivered on behalf of the Municipality by a Service Provider as provided in Bylaw 3-97.
3. Fees relative to the service(s) identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be established by the Service Provider in accordance with the terms of the agreement entered into by the Municipality and Maidstone Waseca and District Fire Board on the 4th of March 1997.
4. The Service Provider shall charge the cost of the fire prevention and suppression services directly to the person or persons who receive service in accordance with Appendix "A".
5. At the request of the Service Provider, if the all or a portion of the charge noted in Section 4 of this bylaw remain unpaid after the end of the calendar year, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.

APPENDIX "A" TO BYLAW 2007-05
