### SNOW PILES

Property owners are reminded that they have 72 hours to remove snow from the sidewalk outside their property after a snow fall.

Snow can NOT be put into the streets, culverts, any public place or private property other than your own.

The town will remove the snow and the cost will be charged back to the property owner.

If you are hiring someone to remove your snow please make sure the contractors haul it to the snow pile across from the cemetery. For further information please contact the town office.

### TAXES

You are able to start making your 2019 property tax payments.

Between January 1, 2019 and July 31, 2019 you will receive a 2% discount on your taxes.
