The Town is ready to deal with the melting snow on the streets but is asking residents to play a role to stop flooding on private property.

Here are some Tips to prevent flooding with the Spring Melt;

- 1. Check your eaves troughs and gutters for signs of ice & debris.
- 2. Shovel snow away from your homes foundation, especially near windows.
- 3. Clear snow from the ends of your downspouts and extend them away from your home by at least 2 meters.
- 4. If you have a sump pump, test it and ensure the discharge hose carries the water at least 2 meters away from your home.
- 5. Ensure discharge hoses and enclosed downspouts are not frozen solid not allowing the water to drain.
- 6. Keep the snow on your yard, shoveling onto streets or into ditches could block the towns drainage system.

(Not so) Fun Facts

- Did you know that a snow pile 20 foot in diameter and 10 foot high contains 2,600 gallons of water!
- Snow melt runoff floods are the most common type of flooding in Canada.
