	POLICY – WASTE/RECYCLE CARTS

<p><u>BACKGROUND</u> In 2016, the Town of Maidstone entered into a residential curbside waste and recycle agreement with Loraas Environmental. Revenues to pay for this service are generated as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Waste = Property tax • Recycle = Utility charge <p>Expenses for this service are based on annual waste and recycle per cart rates multiplied by how many carts are in service.</p> <p><u>PURPOSE OF POLICY</u> To ensure that utility customers are able to rent additional waste and/or recycle carts at a rate consistent with those paid for annual curbside collection services.</p> <p><u>PROCEDURE</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Each utility account is granted one waste and one recycle cart at no additional charge. 2. So long as the waste per cart rate is higher than the recycling per cart rate, a utility account may replace its waste cart with a recycle cart at no additional charge. 3. Extra carts are available for an initial administration fee and a usage fee to be charged to the account each billing cycle. 4. Fees shall be reviewed annually prior to budget preparation. <p><u>FEES</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$25 = Administration • \$26 = Waste (per cart) • \$14 = Recycle (per cart)
