(includes interest paid on waterworks infrastructure loans): \$495,916.33 Total debt payments on waterworks infrastructure loans: \$118,026.94

Comparison of waterworks revenues to expenditures plus debt payments, expressed as a ratio: \$593,558.13 / (\$495,916.33 + \$118,026.94) = 0.97 For 2019, waterworks revenue covered 97% of waterwork expenditures.

Comments: Far higher expenditures on well and water treatment plant repairs, as well as the addition of a water contractor salary made for the significant change from 2018.
