2025 ACHIEVEMENTS

- The new lift station is fully operational. It was tested during the heavy rain event in June, and we experienced zero issues.
- We completed a long stretch of road oiling on 2nd Avenue East, as well as on 4th Street East and 3rd Street East.
 - A new sidewalk was added on 3rd Avenue East, directly across from the school.
 - Swales were added in several locations around town to improve drainage.
 - 6th Ave drainage pump was upgraded.

The town council and staff continue to make meaningful improvements throughout our community, and we can all be proud of what has been accomplished this year.

2025 PROPERTY TAXES

Property taxes were due December 31, 2025. All outstanding balances will incur a 1.25% interest fee on the 1st of every month starting in January 2026.

SNOW REMINDERS

Please help us keep our streets free of snow by following some simple steps:

- Move vehicles off the street during plowing operations.
- When putting garbage and recycle bins out, leave them at the edge of the road.
- Bring your garbage or recycle bins in off the road once empty.
- Give operators plenty of space to work safely.
- Sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 72 hours of the last snowfall.
- Please do not put the snow into the road, your snow must remain on your property.
