Any payments received on or before July 31, 2025 will receive a 2% discount on the municipal portion of your property taxes. This adjusted amount is shown at the bottom of your tax notice

## CAT & DOG OWNER REMINDERS

- All cats and dogs over the age of 3 months must have a Town of Maidstone Pet License (one-time fee of \$25).
- Owners must ensure their cat(s) and/or dog(s) remain on their property, unless they are leashed and under control.
- A maximum of 2 cats and 2 dogs (4 animals total) are allowed at a property.
- Property owners are responsible for the actions of all tenants at their property, and any cats or dogs residing there.
- If an unregistered cat or dog is trapped and impounded by the Town or designated officers, owners may receive fines of at least \$300.

## PAYMENT METHODS

1) **E-transfer** – [townofmaidstone4@sasktel.net](mailto:townofmaidstone4@sasktel.net)  
Please remember to include your account # in the memo

2) **Bill Payee thru a Financial Institution**

CIBC: “Maidstone (Town of) Taxes” or “Maidstone (Town of) Utilities”. Please use your account number and add zeros either before or after as you may need to enter a total of 9 to 11 digits.

Credit Union: “Maidstone (Town):Property Tax” or “Maidstone (Town): Utilities”. Please use your account number and add zeros either before or after so that you are entering a total of 9 digits.

**Cash** – in-person at the Town Office

3) **Cheque** – in-person at the Town Office, in the drop box, or mailed to Box 208, Maidstone, SK S0M 1M0

4) **Debit** – in-person

5) **Credit** – in-person or over the phone (a 3% fee applies to all credit card payments)
